Classic Muscadet, bottled on the 'lees' for extra freshness and flavour.
Crisp, dry and with long lasting flavour.
- 10 **Sancerre 2008/9** 32.25
Domaine Brochard ½ Bottle 17.50
Beautifully crisp and lively on the palate with aromas of green fruit and
cut grass. It has a long lasting flavour and is one of the great partners
to seafood dishes.
- 11 **Quincy 2008** *NEW* 29.25
Domaine Bailly
100% Sauvignon Blanc and a neighbour to Sancerre giving a similar style
of very crisp, intense wine with a mineral character and a long lasting
finish.
- 12 **Pouilly Fume 2009** 28.05
Patrice Moreux ½ Bottle 15.00
Wonderful concentration of fresh gooseberry and cut grass aromas with

BURGUNDY

- 13 **Macon Blanc Villages 2009** 24.75
Joseph Drouhin ½ Bottle 14.55
Pale straw golden colour, exhibiting classic white Burgundy aromas,

butter and bread, with rich chardonnay fruit on the palate.
- 14 **Chablis 2008** 29.50
Domaine Colombier ½ Bottle 18.05
A pure and authentic wine vinified in stainless steel tanks to retain all

its freshness and mineral character.
- 15 **Chablis 1er Cru Fourchaume 2007/8** 42.00
Domaine Colombier
35 year old vines. Richer and more generous on the aroma, but still
light and delicate. Lovely pure fruit combined with slight flint.
Excellent balance.
- 16 **St. Veran 'Fleur' 2008** *NEW* 32.50
Domaine Saumaize - Michelin
Perfect with seared scallops. A touch of toasty oak balanced with lovely
ripe Chardonnay fruit. The most southerly of the white Burgundians this
offers some of the best value.
- 17 **Meursault Adamas 2006** 55.50
Burgundy
A rich and complex wine, it has a very attractive weight of fruit on the
palate with a long, toasty finish with just a hint of just a hint of buttery
richness.

RHONE AND SOUTH

- 18 **Crozes Hermitage Blanc 2008/9** 26.75
Etienne Barret
A blend of Marsanne and Roussanne, this is quite delicious wine with a clean, slightly floral nose and hints of apple on the palate. It is smooth, medium bodied with a long finish. Perfect with simply cooked fish or a good glass on its own.
- 19 **Colombard 2008** 17.20
Champs du Moulin
Cotes de Gascogne
Attractive floral nose, which is due to the Colombard grape, makes this wine extremely attractive from the outset. Lovely crisp and citrusy flavours on the palate leading to a truly satisfying finish. Very moreish!

ALSACE

- 20 **Fleur d'Alsace 2007/8** 22.50
Hugel ½ Bottle 13.70
Allies the suave spicy flavour of Gewurztraminer, the body of Pinot Gris, the finesse of Riesling and the grapiness of Muscat. Excellent with fish.
- 21 **Gewurztraminer 2008** *NEW* 24.50
Joseph Cattin
Classic nose of lychee and flowers, soft full flavoured palate finishing dry. A versatile wine working well with pork, hams and spiced dishes through to strongly flavoured fish like smoked salmon.
- 22 **Riesling 2009** *NEW* 21.50
Joseph Cattin ½ Bottle 12.00
First and foremost this is dry wine. Lime juice aromas and flavours with an intensity and mouth-watering quality only fine Riesling can achieve

ITALY

- 23 **Pinot Grigio 2009** 15.75
La Casada
Veneto
Wonderful cream soda nose, crisp lively acidity backed by classic flavours of melon, peach kernels and a slightly spicy finish.
- 24 **Gavi La Zerba 2007/8** 26.00
Piemonte
This is classic Gavi and very much not of the current fashion for high alcohol and oak. It is lovely and pure with a perfumed nose of honeysuckle and pear. This reflects onto the palate and is balanced by some tropical fruit and lovely mineral fresh acidity.

SPAIN

- 25 **Rioja Blanco Barrel Fermented 2008** *NEW* 20.00
Vina Albina
Fermented in barrels to give some oak character and extra flavour to the wine. Works well with smoked fish and creamy sauces.
- 26 **Albarinho Veiga Naum 2009** *NEW* 23.00
Rias Baixas
Crisp, fresh and lighter in style than most Spanish whites due to Galicia's cooler climate. Now recognised as a classic match for oily fish with its crisp acidity and its hints of aniseed and fennel.

AUSTRALIA

- 27 **Chardonnay 'Unwooded' 2008/9** 18.50
Red Earth
Adelaide Plains
Left unwooded to highlight its natural zesty citrus peach and ripe melon flavours. Fresh and crisp on the finish with a touch of dried pear. Citron hues in the colouring and characteristic leafy honeysuckle on the nose.
- 28 **Gewurztraminer Verdelho 2008/9** 17.50
Opal Ridge
South Australia
A medium wine with a lovely fresh, floral character balanced by crisp acidity. Very fruity, clean and crisp with flavours of Guava and fruit salad.
- 29 **Pinot Grigio 2008** *NEW* 21.75
Ceravolo
Adelaide Plains
A distinctly more flavoursome rendition of this Italian variety. Well balanced and crisp with ripe apple flavours.

NEW ZEALAND

- 30 **Sauvignon Blanc 2009** 24.50
Francesca Bay - Marlborough
Rich aromatics and flavours displaying gooseberries, limes, lemons and grapefruits. Zesty dry on the palate with a flavour that goes on and on.
- 31 **Sauvignon Blanc 2008/9** 50.00
Cloudy Bay - Marlborough
Pale straw green in colour and fragrant, reminiscent of a fruit salsa - peaches, passionfruit, mango and citrus. The palate is succulent, with a zesty apple-sherbet acidity and a long, lingering finish.

CHILE

- 32 **Sauvignon Blanc 2009** 16.00
Santa Ema - Maipo Valley ½ Bottle 9.50
The aroma is a beautifully delicate one of crushed apples and ripe pears with a concentrated palate highlighting the citrus overtone. This Sauvignon Blanc has a long, refreshing finish.
- 33 **Viognier Reserve 2008/9** 20.50
Casa Silva - Colchagua
Distinctive peach and floral aromas of the Viognier grape. Barrel fermented for extra complexity the wine is full flavoured with some weight and power.

CALIFORNIA

- 34 **Chardonnay Viognier 2007** 22.00
Roundhill - Sonoma
A lovely wine that combines ripe apple and pear notes of Chardonnay with the floral and aromatic bouquet of Viognier. The crisp and lush flavour of citrus, apricot and tropical fruit come together in a wonderful, long finish.

SOUTH AFRICA

- 35 **Chenin Blanc 2008/9** 22.00
Mulderbosch - Stellenbosh
On the nose, pineapples, guavas, lemon and lime aromas. A clean, lively wine with nuances of nutmeg and cloves. Well-balanced and elegant, but with weight and full ripe fruit on the palate. Stylistically off-dry and lightly oaked - an excellent food wine.
- 36 **Sauvignon Blanc 2009** *NEW* 16.00
Veldt Range - Robertson
Savour the spectrum of varietal flavours that personifies our Sauvignon Blanc. Both the palate and the nose are dominated by rich, gooseberry and greengage fruits backed by a herbaceous crispness.

ROSE WINES

- 37 **Pinot Grigio Rose 2009** 16.50
La Casada - Veneto
An oddity of the wine world that is wonderfully refreshing, with crisp acidity backed up by pleasant soft, red fruit flavours.
- 38 **Cabernet Rose 2009** 15.75
Las Condes - Chile
Vibrant pink with amazing floral aromas, it has a distinct freshness and strawberry character.

RED WINES

FRANCE

BORDEAUX

- 39 **Les Ormes de Lagrange 2006** 20.50
Bordeaux Supérieur ½ Bottle 12.95
A blend of Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc it offers classic Claret scents & flavours. Deep purple in colour, full of bramble, spice and cedar with a super soft, black-fruited, balanced finish. 2007
- 40 **Chateau de Roques 2004** 26.00
Puyseguin St Emilion
Clear ruby red with a nose that is reminiscent of wild berries. The wine is medium bodied, with lighter tannins and cedary notes enhancing the fruit. Subtle hints of vanilla and oak leads to mouth-filling soft fruit flavours.
- 41 **Chateau de Pez 2004/5** 66.50
St Estephe
Now owned by Louis Roederer and with a burgeoning reputation as each vintage seems to improve. Intense colour and aromas of black fruit and cedar.
- 42 **Les Allées de Cantemerle 2006 (2nd wine of Chateau Cantemerle)** 47.00
Haut - Medoc
Smooth and silky texture with very soft tannins and wonderful notes of spice.

BURGUNDY

- 43 **Rully Rouge 2007** 35.95
Joseph Drouhin ½ Bottle 19.85
A mellow bouquet of soft fruits. Maturing and softening on the palate with a little firmness on the finish. Excellent red burgundy, ideal to drink with poultry or lighter meats.
- 44 **Cote de Beaune 2006/7** 49.50
Joseph Drouhin
Fuller bodied Pinot Noir with classic red fruit and spice character from the southern part of the Cote d'Or.

BEAUJOLAIS

- 45 **Beaujolais Villages 2008** 23.00
Joseph Drouhin ½ Bottle 14.20
It has a bright purple colour, a very intense nose, reminiscent of violets and red berries. On the palate, it has a silky smoothness, and its delicious fruit lingers for a long time. Beaujolais Villages is very versatile with all kinds of food. 2007/8
- 46 **Fleurie 2008** 32.00
Joseph Drouhin ½ Bottle 18.50
The true style of the Gamay - soft summer fruit flavours and juicy finish. 2007

SPAIN

- 56 **Tempranillo 2007** 15.75
Quintana
Vina de la Tierra
This would put many Riojas to shame. Soft, chocolatey Tempranillo fruit rounded out and spiced up by a year in oak barrels. Mellow and medium weight.
- 57 **Rioja Crianza 2006** 20.00
Amate
This Crianza was aged in American oak barrels for 12 months, with a further 12 months in bottle, creating a soft and smooth Rioja with hints of vanilla and chocolate on the nose.
- 58 **Toro Oak Aged 2007** 27.00
Val Viadero
From the neighbouring area to Rioja and using the same grapes, this is a medium-bodied, wonderfully classic, earthy wine from the García Viadero family's new estate.

AUSTRALIA

- 59 **Shiraz 2005/6/8** 20.00
Red Earth
Adelaide Plains
A round and plush deep purple Shiraz with a delicious forward style. Subtle toasty vanilla oak, spices and supple tannins underpin the lingering chocolate and berry flavours of the elegant shining fruit. Aged 12 month on a blend of new and aged American and French oak.
- 60 **Petit Verdot 2007** *NEW* 25.00
Ceravolo
Adelaide Plains
Less than a star in Bordeaux this grape ripens beautifully in the Adelaide sunshine. Very deep and dark. Intense aromas and flavours. Rich black fruit, even chocolate. This is a big wine but so well made it still retains balance.
- 61 **Sangiovese 2006/7** 21.50
Ceravolo
Adelaide Plains
A richly coloured red. Aged in French & American Oak, this Sangiovese, with its fresh, fruity & savoury charm, is a perfect food wine. Bottled with a screwcap to suit Sangiovese's fresh fruity style.
- 62 **Johann's Garden 2004** 37.50
Henschke
Eden Valley
A blend of Grenache, Shiraz and Mourvèdre. Sweet ripe intense spicy rhubarb, plums, anise herbs and mace aromas. Beautiful lush ripe blackberry and mulberry hints on the palate form a central core of fruit; delicious sweet mature velvety tannins and a long finish.

NEW ZEALAND

- 63 Pinot Noir 2008 23.50
Francesca Bay
Marlborough
This wine has a vibrant cherry red colour and an amazing aroma of wild strawberries - the palate is all consuming, rich and velvety with sweet ripe red berry fruits bursting out. A truly elegant but rich Pinot Noir, a lovely wine.

CHILE

- 64 Cabernet Sauvignon 2008/9 17.50
Santa Ema ½ Bottle 9.25
Maipo 2007
Ruby red with garnet hues. Aromas of deep red fruits. Excellent harmonious medium bodied red. A beautifully rich wine!
- 65 Carmenere 2007 21.50
Santa Ema
Cachapoal Valley
A lovely deep red colour with an aroma that mixes fruit - cherries and chocolate and a hint of herbs. On the palate, this is a fully rounded wine with great body concentration. A wonderfully juicy mouthful.
- 66 Merlot 2008 20.00
Casa Silva
Brilliant deep ruby red in colour with a powerful aroma of plum, raspberry and subtle spice. Soft and silky on the palate with great structure and a long finish.

ARGENTINA

- 67 Malbec 2008 20.00
Don Cristobal
Mendoza
At sight, it has intense and bright red purplish tones. Fine and elegant aroma with a perfect combination of ripe red fruits and spices, enriched by the use of French oak. In the mouth it is balanced with soft tannins.

CALIFORNIA

- 68 Zinfandel Shiraz 2006 21.50
Roundhill
Sonoma
A brilliant blend of Zinfandel and Shiraz, warm ripe and spicy. Softly rounded with lots of rich berry fruits, finishing with peppery spice.

SOUTH AFRICA

- 69 Pinotage 2007 26.00
Springfontein
Walker Bay
Red cherry and raspberry with pine tar and a great acidic tingle. Ripe and very good.

70 Shiraz 2009 *NEW* 18.50
 Veldt Range
 Robertson
 This punches well above its weight. Ripe bramble scents and flavours with some smoky oak and great depth. Perfect with a fine steak!

71 Pinot Noir 2006/8 44.00
 Meerlust
 Stellenbosch
 The only Pinot Noir to receive the coveted five star rating in the 2009 Platter guide. Exuberant floral nose with hints of violets, cherries and baking spice. Juicy red fruit flavours and silky, supple tannins.

 Rhone
 Quite stunning with fresh grape aromas, honeysuckle and even lychees. Rich, sweet and luscious on the palate with just enough balancing acidity.

73 Semillon Gewürztraminer 2009 ½ Bottle 20.50
 Late Harvest, Casa Silva Chile 50ml Glass 3.25
 Superbly balanced dessert wine with notes of grapefruit and orange peel on the nose. The palate is sweet yet refreshing with the high acidity levels and finishes well.

74 Late Harvest Shiraz 'Raconteur' *NEW* ½ Bottle 29.00
 Ceravolo, Australia 50ml Glass 4.05
 Deep purple-red; dense, dark depth of richest chocolate and blueberry pudding imaginable.

HOUSE WINES

75 Grenache Blanc 2009 15.75
 Cuvee Valonnee
 Vin de Pays d'Oc
 Pale in colour. The aroma is one of green apples with flavours of peach and nectarines. The richness and crisp acidity make this a perfect aperitif wine, complementing all fish and white meat dishes.

76 Syrah 2008 15.75
 Cuvee Valonnee
 Vin de Pays d'Oc
 Deep colour with aromas of bramble jam and spice. Full flavoured giving a taste of Southern France.
