WHITE WINES

Grenache Blanc, Cuvee Valonnee **Vin de Pays – France**

Pale in colour. Aromas of green apples with flavours of peach and nectarines. The rich crisp acidity make this a perfect aperitif wine. (13% vol)

Pinot Grigio, La Casada **Veneto - Italy**

Wonderful cream soda nose, crisp acidity backed by classic flavours of melon, peach kernels and a slightly spicy finish. (12% vol)

Sauvignon Blanc, La Doutelle **Vin de Pays – France**

Pronounced aromas of apples followed by rich, dry greengage and grapefruit characteristics with a long elegant finish. (12.5% vol)

Chardonnay, Las Condes **Central Valley - Chile**

Fresh tropical fruits on the nose with a rounded easy drinking style. Medium dry and unoaked. (13% vol)

Muscadet de Sevre et Maine 22.00 **Loire - France**

Classic Muscadet, bottled on the 'lees' for extra freshness and flavour. Crisp, dry and with long lasting flavour. (12% vol)

Sauvignon Blanc, Francesca Bay 24.95 **Marlborough - New Zealand**

Rich aromatics and flavours displaying gooseberries, limes, lemons and grapefruits. Zesty dry on the palate with a flavour that goes on and on. (13.5% vol)

Chablis, Domaine Colombier 30.50 **Burgundy - France**

A pure and authentic wine vinified in stainless steel tanks to retain all its freshness and mineral character. (13% vol)

Sancerre, Domaine Brochard 32.95 **Loire - France**

Beautifully crisp and lively with aromas of green fruit and cut grass. It has a long lasting flavour. A great partners to seafood. (13% vol)

RED WINES

Syrah, Cuvee Valonnee **Vin de Pays - France**

Deep colour with aromas of bramble jam and spice. Full flavoured giving a taste of southern France. (12.5% vol)

Tempranillo, Quintana **Spain**

This would put many Riojas to shame. Soft, chocolatey Tempranillo fruit rounded out and spiced up by a year in oak barrels. Mellow and medium weight. (13% vol)

Merlot, La Doutelle **Southern France**

A fruity yet earthy wine that can be enjoyed with a variety of meals. Round, fruity and well-balanced with plum and berry flavours and a smooth finish, all supported by ripe tannins. (13% vol)

Cabernet Sauvignon, Las Condes **Central Valley - Chile**

Dark coloured with smoky and spicey notes. Black-currant aromas and tastes predominate on the palate. (13.5% vol)

Montepulciano d'Abruzzo 19.50 **Paradiso - Italy**

New fashionable red from the Adriatic coast. Juicy, cherry style fruit. Medium bodied. (12% vol)

Pinot Noir, Francesca Bay 23.50 **Marlborough - New Zealand**

Of vibrant cherry red colour and an amazing aroma of strawberries – the palate is all consuming, rich and velvety with sweet ripe red berry fruits bursting out. A truly elegant but rich Pinot Noir, a lovely wine. (13.5% vol)

Petit Verdot, Ceravolo 25.50 **Adelaide Plains - Australia**

Very deep and dark. Intense aromas and flavours. Rich black fruit, even chocolate. A big wine but it retains balance. (13.5% vol)

Fleurie, Joseph Drouhin 32.95 **Beaujolais - France**

The true style of the Gamay – soft summer fruit flavours and juicy finish. (13% vol)
