

## Whites

### Grenache Blanc Cuvee Valonnee Vin de Pays – France

Pale in colour. The aroma is one of green apples with flavours of peach and nectarines. The richness and crisp acidity make this a perfect aperitif wine, complementing all fish and white meat dishes. (13% vol)



### Pinot Grigio Las Casada Veneto - Italy

Wonderful cream soda nose, crisp lively acidity backed by classic flavours of melon, peach kernels and a slightly spicy finish. (12% vol)



### Sauvignon Blanc La Doutelle Vin de Pays – France

This wine exhibits pronounced aromas of green apples followed by rich, dry greengage and grapefruit characteristics with a long elegant finish. (12.5% vol)



### Chardonnay Las Condes Chile

Fresh tropical fruits on the nose with a rounded easy drinking style. Medium dry and unoaked. (13% vol)

## Rosé

### Cabernet Rose Las Condes Central Valley - Chile

Vibrant pink in colour with amazing floral aromas, this wine has a distinct freshness and strawberry character. (13.5% vol)

## Reds

### Syrah Cuvee Valonnee Vin de Pays - France

Deep colour with aromas of bramble jam and spice. Full flavoured giving a taste of southern France. (12.5% vol)



### Tempranillo Quintana Spain

This would put many Riojas to shame. Soft, chocolatey Tempranillo fruit rounded out and spiced up by a year in oak barrels. Mellow and medium weight. (13% vol)



### Merlot La Doutelle Vin de Pays – France

Soft rounded medium weight red with ripe red fruit flavours. (13% vol)

### Cabernet Sauvignon Las Condes Chile

Dark coloured with smoky and spicy notes. Black-currant aromas and tastes predominate on the palate. (13.5% vol)
